“Sewing / Textile Arts” Continuing Education Arts Series

Submission Deadline: October 27, 2017

Overview: Six Nations Polytechnic is seeking highly motivated individuals who would like to co-develop Continuing Education (CE) Textile Arts Series workshops. These CE workshop classes will be delivered in an interactive and hands-on workshop format. Individuals who wish to submit their proposal must be able to articulate the steps of the activity within the workshop via a lesson plan, and if possible identify the learning outcomes of the workshop.

Possible topics / workshops include:

- Moss Bag
- Ribbon Shirt (basic)
- Ribbon Shirt (advanced)
- Ribbon Skirt
- Basic Ribbon Dress
- Men’s Leggings
- Women’s Leggings
- Other types of textile arts topics

Context: For this CE Arts Series, students will learn the basics of sewing Ogwehoweh clothing and other items whilst learning to actively maintain and preserve a piece of Hodinohso:ni culture and tradition. The instructor will articulate the steps necessary to complete a textile arts / sewing project (ideas listed above).

Compensation: Successful candidates will be compensated \$350.00 for completion of a detailed lesson plan based on an agreed upon workshop topic. There is opportunity for further compensation for individuals who continue on in an instructing capacity for workshop delivery.

Proposals will be accepted until 4pm on October 16, 2017.

Proposals should include:

3. Artists’ portfolio (optional)
