#### Overview:

Six Nations Polytechnic has an immediate need for Instructors within the faculty of Trades department for a Welder/Fitter program starting on March 26, 2018. The successful candidate will be responsible for providing academic leadership as well as developing and nurturing a safe, positive and effective learning environment.

#### Responsibilities:

The duties of this position will include, but are not limited to the following:

- Identify, source, purchase and have available all required equipment, texts and supplies, when and where needed for the effective delivery of the program.
- Ensure the required curriculum is developed and effectively delivered using a variety of teaching and learning strategies that will provide the best learning outcomes for students.
- Utilize a variety of methods as allowed to evaluate student understanding and success.
- Track student progress and identify, and provide extra supports where needed.
- Submit grades and attendance in a timely manner as per policy.
- Communicate on a regular basis with administrative team and direct manager on all issues and developments within the program.
- Liaise with community partners to enhance the profile of SNP and the program. This includes our educational partners, employers, community agencies and government representatives.

#### **Qualifications:**

In addition to technical qualifications in the required trades, the successful candidate must have an ability to relate theoretical knowledge and practical applications through innovative delivery methods so as to provide a meaningful learning environment for students of diverse backgrounds and ages. The ability to work as a part of a team and demonstration of excellent interpersonal and communication skills are essential.

Faculty members hired at Six Nations Polytechnic must be prepared to teach with a learner-centered approach and to assist in the development and application of alternate delivery methods. Prior teaching experience at a post secondary and apprenticeship level is a definite asset.
